### **Procedures for Connecting to SUNY-ADK on the Wireless Network**

The procedure for logging into the new SUNY-ADK wireless network connection is as follows:

1. On your mobile device, you will see **SUNY-ADK** as an available wireless network in your WiFi list.
2. Select SUNY-ADK and enter your username, password and other requested information. (**Do not select SUNY-ADK-Guest** - this is reserved for a subsequent phase of our wireless network project that is coming soon! It is important to note that the wireless settings are different based on the type of device you are using. Please see below for additional detail for connecting some of the more common mobile devices. Also, your username and password will be the same ones that you use to log into our network.)
3. Once you have entered your connection information, select Join (or Connect on some devices).
4. You may be asked to accept the server's certificate. Select Trust (or Continue on some devices) when prompted.

**It may take a few minutes to connect when you log into SUNY-ADK for the first time.** However, once you have established your connection, you should immediately reconnect when you are in range of our updated wireless network.

### **Connection Information for Common Mobile Devices**

#### **Apple iOS iPhone, iPad or iPod Touch**

1. From the home screen, tap "Settings".
2. Tap "Wi-Fi"; it will scan for available networks.
3. Select '**SUNY-ADK**'.
4. When prompted for a username/password, enter your **Network Username and Password**.
5. Tap "Join" in lower-right-hand corner.
6. The first time you connect, you will be asked to accept the server's certificate.
7. Top corner - hit Trust.

#### **Android**

1. Select and Enable WiFi on your device.
2. Tap the network '**SUNY-ADK**'.
3. Enter the following information:
  - a. EAP method: PEAP Phase 2
  - b. Authentication: None (if available) or MSCHAPV2 CA
  - c. Certificate: Unspecified (only option)
  - d. Client Certificate: Unspecified (only option)
  - e. Identity: **Your Network Username**
  - f. Anonymous Identity: leave blank
  - g. Wireless Password: **Your Network Password**
4. The first time you connect, you will be asked to accept the server's certificate. Select "Continue" at the prompt. You will only need to accept the certificate the first time you authenticate to '**SUNY-ADK**.' After that, authentication will be automatic.

#### **ChromeBook**

1. On the bottom right hand corner of the screen, click on the wireless icon.

2. Click on "Settings".
3. Under "Internet Connection", choose the drop-down under "Wi-Fi network".
4. Select '**SUNY-ADK**' from the list of networks (you may have to scroll the list to find it)
5. Click on "Connect"
6. Enter the following information:
  - a. SSID: **SUNY-ADK**
  - b. EAP method: PEAP
  - c. Phase 2 authentication: MSCHAPv2
  - d. Server CA certificate: Do not check
  - e. User certificate: Leave blank
  - f. Identity: **Your Network Username**
  - g. Password: **Your Network Password**
  - h. Anonymous Identity: Leave blank
  - i. Save identity and password: This should be checked
7. Click "Connect"
